ANNUAL REPORT

To the Members of the Middle Harbour Cricket Club

Gentlemen,

The Committee beg to submit their Report for the Season, 1906-7.

The three teams engaged in District Competitions met with a fair amount of success.

The 1st eleven played 10 matches, won 2, lost 6, drew 2 and came 10th on the list.

The 2nd eleven played 12 matches, won 2, lost 10 and were placed 16th in the Competition.

The 3rd eleven, after several very creditable victories, secured 11th place ; they played 10 matches, won 3, lost 6 and drew 1, also tied with Sydney III.

The best individual batting performances were those of P. J. Carew of the 1st team, C. B. Cochrane of the 2nd team and H. Cropper of the 3rd team. Centuries were scored by P. J. Carew (123 not out) and J. Hodgkinson (100 not out) for the 1st eleven and by F. L. Row (108) for the 2nd eleven.

As bowlers H. Whiddon, C. Woods and J. A. Stevens were most successful for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd teams respectively. Mention can also be made of the good performance of H. C. Cropper, who bowled in both 2nd and 3rd teams and secured the greatest number of wickets, viz., 38.

Financially the season has been most satisfactory. The committee are pleased to report that after discharging all liabilities the year closed with a credit balance of £134 19s 8d a net increase of £15 5s 4d on the previous year.

The Oval was fully occupied for Wednesday and other week-day matches.

The Club Membership is encouraging, there being now 87 on the roll. The Committee wish to record their protest of the treatment of the 2nd and 3rd teams, with regard to the number of matches allotted to them on the Domain, whilst quite ready to accept their fair share, they were hardly prepared for a monopoly of which is without doubt the worst ground around Sydney.

The Club will, it is felt sure, heartily congratulate the N.S.W. Cricket Association on the establishment of a fully representative Board of Control.

The Committee are sorry to announce the retirement of Mr. Daniel Hogan. As a Secretary and also a Delegate to the N.S.W.C.A. Mr. Hogan has largely contributed of late years to the success of the Club and his retirement will be very much regretted.

The sincere thanks of all the Members are due to Mrs. W. S. Mitchell; she, with the assistance of other Ladies, regularly dispensed Afternoon Tea, and all Players greatly appreciate these kindly services. Thanks are also due to all those Gentlemen who have supported the Club financially and to His Worship the Mayor and Aldermen for their cordial interest throughout the Season.
